Tasks you can do:

1. Compile a list of at least 4 famous serial killers, their crimes, the dates they were active and the details of their capture and punishments. Are there any patterns? **(60 points)**
2. Create a diagram that details how the British Criminal Justice system works. For example: What are the types of court cases? Who is involved in the criminal justice system? How does a case get to court? How is a jury selected? **(60 points)**
