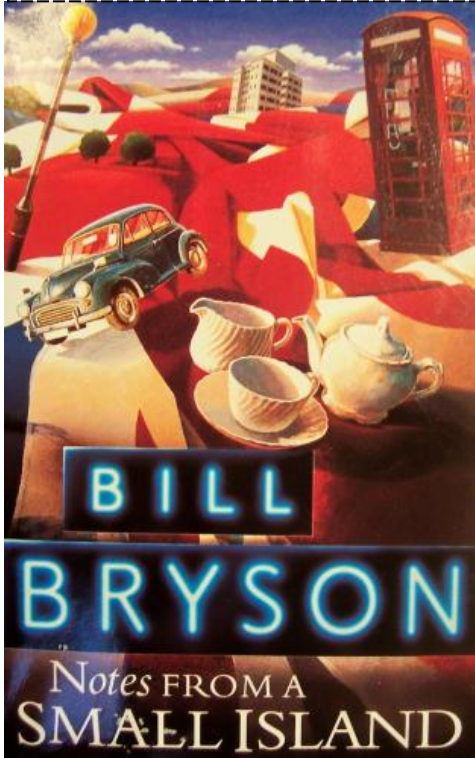


Post-16 Transition Geography work!
