(which is the best work? Why?)

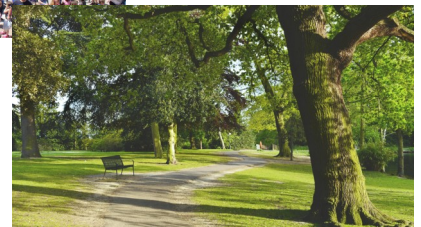
What do you get/feel from the work? Which parts did you not understand or dislike? Why? Anything that inspired you?)
