- memories and bonding


9. Careers guidance and support

Excellence through teamwork


To us, this means, as a team of students, staff, families, and community, we strive to achieve a common purpose of excellent outcomes for all.



When students start, they join a tutor group where they develop supportive bonds with their peers and tutor. We place great emphasis on helping everyone feel at home and settled as quickly as possible.






