
# **TUXFORD ACADEMY DRAMA** LEARNING JOURNEY

#### **UNIT 5: BLOOD BROTHERS** How do we analyse play text?

Exploring social context, characterisation, themes, structure and plot of the play of Blood Brothers. Students introduced to the role of a director and continue to work in groups staging the dramatic work of Blood Brothers.

## **UNIT 4: WAR & CONFLICT**

How does war affect people's lives? Mastering drama conventions such as splitstage, choral speech, cross-cutting and sound college to explore the impact of WW1/2. Students introduced to devising through creating work from a stimulus.

Students explore conflict on stage through practical stage combat lessons.

### UNIT 7: DEVISING 9/11 What is Physical Theatre & Symbolism? Using abstract methods such as imagery, chairs duet and physcial theatre to explore the themes,

stories and impact of the 9/11 event.



## **UNIT 2: DARKWOOD MANOR**

How do you create character? Creating fictional characters and working through whole class exercises to investigate a haunted manor. Exploring Tension and how to create mood and atmosphere on stage.

Students work in groups to build team-work & social skills.

Students continue to work in groups developing empathy and leadership skills.
