HALF TERM 3 MOTOWN R&B

This topic of work develops pupils understanding of Keyboard skills and teaches pupils to combine the left and right hands when performing Music

HALF TERM 4 Film/TV

composition

Pupils will learn to compose short pieces of music to accompany a scene from different genres of films/ games/TV.

HALF TERM 5 Rock Music

Pupils will be exploring Rock Music and

performing on various instruments.

HALF TERM 6 Riffs & Hooks

Pupils will explore famous Riffs and Hooks from Popular Music and compose their own Riffs and Hooks using Music Technology.

HALF TERM 1 Introducing Performance Techniques

Performance Skills & Listening Skills. Pupils will be learning how to develop their knowledge of performing and extend their current musical standard

HALF TERM 6 Build a Band

Pupils will create their own Band, Vocalist, Keyboard, Drums and Guitar. Pupils will learn how to play new instruments and identify their strengths on their individual Instruments

HALF TERM 5 Film Music

This unit develops the performance and composition side to music. Pupils will learn about the background to different types of film music (silent movie music and the different genres of film music such as, Romantic, Action and Horror) and what influenced the style of music.

TERM 2 Creating Music for a **Sporting event**

Using Mixcraft/Midi Keyboards pupils will compose for a sporting brief.

Pupils will be focusing on developing knowledge around the keyboard and voice.

HALF TERM 2 and 3 Brass Band

With the resources we have at Tuxford we are going to integrate Brass lesson into the curriculum and give every pupil the chance to learn a Brass Instrument. Pupils will explore how to play the Cornet, Horn, Trombone and Tuba.

Pupils will learn about the Instruments of the Orchestra. We will focus on Performance and composition techniques and gaining knowledge about the different Instruments of the Orchestra.

HALF TERM 4 African Drumming

Pupils will perform and learn how to play the African Drums. Pupils will develop compositional, performance and ensemble techniques.

HALF TERM 1 An Introduction to Music – 4 Chords

Pupils will be focussing on keyboard skills and vocal skills. In the lesson pupils will be assessed on their performance of chords C, G, Am and F. Pupils will sing, perform on the keyboard and perform in pairs or groups.
