Student needs are prioritised for interview.</li> <li>○ WeDuc messages about local apprenticeships, College and University Open Days are sent to Year 11, 12, 13 parents/carers.</li> <li>○ Destination data for Years 11 and 13 is collected and shared with the local authority at key points during the year.</li> <li>○ All faculties sign post careers related to their subjects through displays and links to external speakers and visits.</li> </ul>
